Please join us for the D30 Fall Conference hosted by America's Boating Club – Grand Lake. We have booked Eagle's Landing Resort for the conference.

- Eagle's Landing has ten 1-bedroom (\$90 per night) and eleven 2-bedroom (\$100 per night) cabins on their property. If you have not reserved these cabins yet, availability may be limited. For reservations call (918) 786-6196.
- There is also a newly renovated Days Inn located at 10400 US-59 North in Grove. For reservations call (918) 786-9799.
- There is also a Best Western Timber Ridge Hotel in Grove located at 120 W 18th Street in Grove. For reservations call (918) 786-6900.

Check-in will begin on Friday, October 4, at 3 pm in the Eagles's Landing Event Center. ABC-Grand Lake will sponsor the Friday opening event starting with happy hour followed by heavy hors d'oeuvres prepared by our members, allowing plenty of time for socializing.

We are hoping for drier weather this year, so we can enjoy some free time on Saturday afternoon seeing the sights of Grand Lake by boat. Grand Lake has a surface area of 41,779 acres and 460 miles of shoreline. Unlike other lakes in Oklahoma, Grand Lake is a deep and mostly rocky lake. The average depth for Grand Lake is 36.3 feet. Its mean elevation is 745 feet above sea level. Grand Lake and its neighbor, Lake Hudson, are the only two major lakes in the state where one can build directly on the waterfront.

However, if Mother Nature does not cooperate, there are other activities to enjoy.

- **Pensacola Dam** is claimed to be the longest multiple arch dam in the world, its main span consisting of 51 arches totaling 5,145 feet in length and supporting a walkway and narrow two-lane highway. A 120 megawatt, 6-unit powerhouse sits at the west end, with 21 spillways on the east end. Another mile east, through the town of Disney, lie two small sister dams known as "the spillways" with an additional 21 gates, surrounded by public parks and launching ramp.
- **Lendonwood Gardens** is an eight-acre botanical garden located in Grove. Shady pathways meander through more than 1200 different types of plants including an amazing collection of rhododendrons, many varieties of daylilies, and several varieties of dogwoods. Admission is \$5. Maps and information for self-guided tours are in the gatehouse by the front gate.

- **Har-Ber Village Museum** is a pioneer-era village and history museum located on the shores of Grand Lake. Visitors experience the area's history and ecology through self-guided tours. Antiques, collectibles and reproductions are displayed in exhibitions representing the mid-1800s to the early 1900s in the local four-state region. Several of the Village's HISTORIC BUILDINGS were relocated to the grounds, including a schoolhouse, jail and 16 log cabins. Other log structures were built to house collections and are typical for the mid-to-late 1800s-a courthouse, a bank, a stagecoach inn and a church built with bricks hand-made before the Civil War. Admission for adults is \$10 and for seniors 63+ and military is \$7.50.
- Though it's a small town, Grove features quite a few **Antique Shops**, each as interesting as the next.
- For those who enjoy games of chance, there are two casinos in the immediate vicinity: **Cherokee Casino** and **Grand Lake Casino**.
- For those looking for something active to do, hike the Har-Ber Village nature trail. If you want to chill out, take in a matinee movie at the Grove Cinema.
